It's time to register for Theatrecraft Youth Unlimited (TYU) Winter & Spring drama camps.

These two residential intensives (5 nights, 6 days) are for 13–21 year olds (Year 7+) with an interest in performing arts to train together, led by industry professionals who have diverse industry experience, and a passion for developing young artists. Beautiful Allambee Camp, West Gippsland, is the venue for these programs, accessible by V-Line services (to Yarragon Station) for independent travellers.

Further develop your skills in theatre performance, voice and movement with likeminded people from all over Victoria. At these 2 camps you will use a range of performance making approaches, scripted and non-scripted.

Your \$600* participation fee is all inclusive (the theatre program, your accommodation, food and specific (non-public) transport as needed. - Lucid Writing
- Collaborative script development
- Finding a common cause to develop and explore as a topic

Have work produced by end of week, participants walk away with something they have created

Lucid writing on a theme/issue to produce starting points to build on (an approach we used in 2017 with two early career writers Stephanie Clark and Didem Caia to develop a suite of multiple short stories for performance presented as *The Places You'll Go* which was performed in 2018 in Bendigo and Trafalgar)

- Includes an informal performance outcome based on some of the work created in the Winter intensive.

This program will build on scripts/ideas that have filtered through since Autumn, but Autumn attendance is not a prerequisite.

Use of filming and transcribing to capture improvisation and text.

Create a compilation/functional record of the works in progress and consideration of potential for future development. This written and visual record will be available for sharing and or future development for performance.
